

# **World Student Christian Federation Liaison**

## *What is the job?*

The World Student Christian Federation (WSCF) Liaison is the ASCM's point of contact for the WSCF. The Liaison is expected to take any necessary action following correspondence from the WSCF.

The WSCF is an international association of Student Christian Movements from over 95 countries in the world. It is divided into 6 regions, with Australia belonging to the Asia-Pacific Region. Each year both the Region and the whole Federation organise programs to which ASCM can send representatives.

## *What is the ASCM?*

The Australian Student Christian Movement is a movement of students interested in exploring questions of faith in an open, ecumenical environment and living the faith through acts of justice in the world.

## *What is expected?*

The WSCF Liaison is the primary point of contact between the WSCF and the ASCM. This position is expected to:

- respond appropriately to all communication from WSCF,
- advertise WSCF programs to ASCM members,
- actively seek potential delegates for WSCF programs,
- know ASCM and WSCF policies regarding the selection of delegates to programs,
- coordinate the selection process for WSCF delegates,

- ensure delegates are appropriately prepared before attending a program,
- ensure delegates have access to appropriate debriefing and support following a program, and
- ensure delegates fulfil their obligations to ASCM as a result of participating in a program.

## *What resources are required?*

The WSCF Liaison is expected to have access to email and a telephone.

## *What skills are expected?*

The WSCF Liaison must have sufficient knowledge of the ASCM and WSCF to be able to respond appropriately to correspondence. It would be an advantage if a person in this position had previously attended a WSCF program. The WSCF Liaison should have contacts within the current membership of ASCM, in order to seek out and encourage the most appropriate people to attend programs. It is expected that the WSCF Liaison has basic counselling skills to provide adequate debriefing, or can responsibly delegate this requirement.

## *What is the commitment?*

The WSCF Liaison is expected to take on this position for two to four years. An honorarium of \$800 per year will be paid, along with reimbursement of associated costs, such as postage and telephone.
